































The detailed analysis of Feedback Report on the overall aspects of college is summarized and following actions have been taken on the basis of the analysis of feedback for the current academic year.

- 1. A Career oriented online Webinar Lecture series on Research & Development was conducted by Department of Botany to enhance employability skills.
- 2. The link of open access repositories such as National Digital Library of India [ndl.gov.in]. e-pathshala, e-Gyankosh and SWAYAM to attend different MOOCs relevant to their subjects being shared among students by departmental communication media for accessing E-content(s), Additionally, A Computer with high-speed (80Mbps) broadband connection is installed, students are being informed about it, a plan for restricted WiFi Access in the library for students is being formulated.
- 3. Botany Department organized a number of local field visit for students and planned to organize a long excursion to Kurseong and Darjeeling to promote experiential learning for the students. Other departments are also encouraged to conduct such excursions.
- 4. Career Council Cell planned to organize a special session on Learning Animation with Vanik group and with George Telegraph.
